Environmental Solar Responds to BP Oil spill in Gulf

Summerville, South Carolina, 7 June, 2010: Environmental Solar Industries, llc. is seeking partners in creating a solar coalition to reduce demand on petroleum based energy. ESI is pledging to forego the costs of installation for all residential solar photovoltaic systems and small commercial systems. The recent environmental catastrophe in the gulf has raised questions about how to supply a growing demand for energy in the United States without negatively impacting the lives of its citizens. ESI wants to reintroduce solar energy as a viable alternative to petroleum. The high cost associated with Solar Power is a barrier to acceptance in the Lowcountry of South Carolina. The cost reduction is about 30% of a normal turnkey photovoltaic electric system. So, to show how committed I am to sharing and establishing that idea I am donating my time for the rest of the year to doing just that." Solar PV systems do require a considerable investment of cash, most of which is recovered within a few months through state and federal tax incentives. Utility companies are now purchasing solar power from their customers. South Carolina is situated so that its solar resources are abundant and well suited to producing lots of electricity. System components carry warranties of up to 25 years and have life spans of up to 50 years.

Environmental Solar Industries, llc. was started in 2008 by Mr. Witherspoon, a resident of Summerville and graduate of Charleston Southern University. Since that time ESI's customers have generated about 1.5 Megawatts of electricity. ESI designs, sells, and installs Solar Photovoltaic
